### **Divisions:**

**Collegiate:** Must be currently enrolled in a Trade School, Junior College, or College/University

**High School:** Squad of 5 from same high school. 2011 graduates still eligible to compete with same school.

**High School Open:** Squad may represent different high schools. 2011 graduates still eligible.

**FFA:** Squad of 5 from same high school. 2011 graduates still eligible to compete with same school.

**Junior High Open:** Students entering 9<sup>th</sup> grade still eligible to compete as Jr. High squad.

**4H, Boy Scouts, Church groups Ect.** Are welcome. They will compete in the High school Open or Jr High Open

### **ANNOUNCEMENT:**

MYSSA and Midway USA Foundation have partnered to create permanent funding for high school shooting teams in Missouri. MYSSA will award to the high school division money to be placed in each schools Scholastic Shooting Trust account at Midway USA Foundation, Inc. Every high school that registers a team and participates will receive \$2,000 in their school accounts and the first place high school team will receive an additional \$5,000, second place an additional \$3,500 and third place an additional \$2,500. To qualify the team must be comprised of high school students from the same school and the award will be placed in their endowment account at Midway USA Foundation. This account is a permanent funding source whereby the team may ask each year for the earning from the account to fund shooting activities. Lady: Champion, Runner-up, Third, Fourth and Fifth

Collegiate Lady: Champion and runner up.

Note: Lady must declare upon entry to be eligible

**Tied Scores:**

Ties for Team placements will be determined by shoot-off.

Ties for High Overall will be determined by shoot-off yardage increases if still tied.

Ties for Champion in each Division will be determined by 5 target miss and out shoot off  
Yardage increase each 5 target tie.

Any other Tie for placement will be determined by reverse score by sub event.
